



Welcome to St. Alphonsus Summer Camp. To our new campers, we hope you have a wonderful summer spent with us. To our returning campers, thank you for joining us again. We can't wait for a fun filled summer!

We will not be having a parent meeting this year. I will try to answer as many questions as I can in this letter. Summer camp T-shirts should be arriving soon. I am planning on sending them home with your child through school. If your child doesn't attend SAS, you may pick them up in the school office or the morning of the week your child will attend camp. I will also be attaching with your shirts the weeks that you signed up your child(ren). The camp field trip schedule should be on the school website soon. I have a couple of more trips I am trying to finalize. I will send out an email when it is posted.

Reminders:

****Payment of 150.00 per camper is due on the Monday of camp. **You are responsible for payment for the weeks you signed up your child, EVEN IF YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE AT CAMP. I must know a week in advance (the Monday before)** Field trips are paid for a week or two in advance.

Start time: is 7:30 (no early drop offs) Drop off is in the cafeteria the first door closest to the school office. You must sign your child in and sign out every day.

Close time: is 5:30 (a late fee of a dollar a minute applies if your child is picked up after 5:30. You must pay the workers cash at the time of late pick up). We are here 10 hours a day so please make sure your child is picked up no later than 5:30. The only people allowed to sign out your child are those that are listed on the emergency contact list. Please let us know if any additions need to be made to that list. If we don't recognize the person picking up your child, identification will be requested.

Bring a box lunch (no lunches are provided) we will provide breakfast (pop tart, go gurt) until 8:00 and snacks around 3:00 (goldfish, chips, etc.) Send a labeled **water bottle** for your child. **PLEASE NO CUPS WITH STRAWS**

Camp shirts must be worn on all off campus field trips and when attending VBS. We will go on offsite field trips Mon –Thurs. with the exception of VBS week and Fridays. Please note leave times on the camp field trip schedules. We will leave promptly at these stated times. Please look at what shoes to wear on certain days and if sunscreen or bug spray is needed. If you miss the bus you can meet the bus or your child(ren) with have to stay with myself or someone in the school office until the campers return.

Behavior on field trips: If for any reason your child misbehaves or an incident with behavior arises he/she may not be allowed to attend a field trip the following day. Administration will make the final decision on this matter.

I can't stress this enough!!! Please label anything and everything that comes to camp.

Campers will be allowed electronic devices again this year. The campers are only allowed to play with the devices at certain times during the day. **Please label everything and are aware that we're not responsible for any lost, broken, or misplaced items. STUDENTS MAY NOT ACCESS THE INTERNET AT ANY TIME!**

If you child is entering Pre K4 – 1st grade: Campers must bring a nap mat. They will nap or rest from 1:00-2:30 everyday . Please bring a change of clothes for your camper- socks, undies, shorts and a shirt in a zip lock bag with name on bag and clothing inside of bag. Make sure items in the bag are also, labeled.

Individual cubbies will be provided for every camper.

VBS is the week of June 10th-June 14th All campers will attend.

Water days on Friday: Girls must wear a one piece bathing suit. If they don't have a one piece, a shirt must be worn over the bathing suit. You may put sunscreen on your child before arrival time. If you choose not to do this, please make sure that the sunscreen that you send is a spray and that they can lather themselves.
