


Hurricane Ida Make Up Day

We are hoping that no other weather emergency days will be necessary! As of now, we have two of the five days we were closed to add to our calendar. We have not received final approval from the Diocese of Baton Rouge Catholic School's Office, but we submitted plans to use January 3, 2022 as a make up day. This day was originally planned as a teacher only day. The second day will be made up by adding minutes to our day that are already built in to use for morning assembly. Because we are not holding in-person assembly, we can add that time back into our day to supply the time needed for a second make up day. If any other emergency days are needed, we will use our contingency days set aside for Mardi Gras break.

We are very excited to get back to Drama this year. We are looking forward to a great year with some wonderful performances!


