Red Ribbon Week Activities

October 25th-29th

The Red Ribbon organization serves as a catalyst to mobilize communities to educate youth and encourage participation in drug prevention activities. This year our Red Ribbon Week will be held from October 25th - October 29th. During this week, we will have various dress days and activities for the students.

**Please note that all dress days are optional. Students may wear regular spirit dress or regular school uniforms if they do not wish to participate in the specific Red Ribbon dress day.

Monday - October 25th Proud to be Drug

Free - Students may wear a red shirt with school uniform bottoms or jeans and school approved red accessories such as socks, bows, and headbands. No hats, sunglasses, bandanas, etc.

Tuesday - October 26th

Put Drugs to Sleep -Students may wear pajama pants with your uniform shirt or SAS spirit shirt. Pajama pants must be appropriate for a school setting and loose fitting. Athletic shoes

only, no slippers.
