Deadline approaching...Re-enrollment for currently enrolled students and new siblings is open now. The deadline for re-registration is January 13, 2023. In order to guarantee a spot for your child for the 2023-2024 school year, he/she must be re-registered by this date. The registration fee will increase to \$350.00 on January 14, 2023 and up to \$400 on January 23, 2023. 
Beta Induction

To Reserve your tickets/tables, please fill out the attached forms and submit it to Home and School by January 23rd. We can't wait to see you there!!


God's Helping Hands

The CONCEPT Behind the LOGO
