Office Entrance Access System

As part of our commitment to provide our students, faculty, staff, and visitors with the safest possible environment, a new buzzer/camera system was installed this week. Visitors to the school office will notice that we have implemented an access control system at our front door (Frenchtown Road entrance). Visitors will ring the doorbell to alert our office staff and be greeted and identified using the camera and intercom system. Once identified, visitors will be "buzzed" into the building. 
