
#### **Child Nutrition Summer Feeding Site**

The Child Nutrition Program will be serving free meals to students 18 years and younger in and around our communities this summer.

Please see the schedule below for the community Summer Feeding dates. The meals are served from 9AM-12PM. Each site will receive 750 boxes to be handed out to students by our staff, regardless of income or location of residence. Boxes will be available until supplies run out, so it is a first come, first serve basis. Each box contains 7 breakfasts, 7 lunches, and 1 gallon of milk. Each child will receive 1 box. If a child is not present during pickup, a form will need to be filled out by the adult picking up.
