Morning Carpool






Save the Date - Remembering Our Children Candlelight Service

From the day we got married, we knew we wanted lots of children to fill our home and hearts. It took many years, but we were finally blessed with 3 beautiful daughters, Stacey, Shelley, & Jodi. We were completely devoted to them, and they have always been our pride and joy. We have also been blessed with 7 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren.

We lost our oldest daughter, Stacey, 9 years ago as a result of a very tragic ATV accident on Memorial Day weekend in 2011. She was only 37 years old, and the mother of an amazing 13 year old son, Ben. It was the worst pain we have ever felt and still feel the hole that she left in our lives and in our hearts every day. Knowing we would never hear her voice again was impossible to imagine, yet it was our new reality.

We are very proud of the choice Stacey made long before her death to be an organ donor. As bittersweet as it is for us, we find comfort in knowing that Stacey's courageous decision saved the lives of 4 people. We have met the wonderful man whose life was saved by receiving her heart. In meeting him, we were able to hear our sweet girl's heart beating strong because of the most amazing gift of life she gave when her life ended.

Our family is so very close, and we keep our memories alive with all the wonderful times we spent with Stacey while she was here on Earth with us. It warms our hearts to know that Stacey lives on through the lives that she saved. We miss her smile, her laugh, her positivity, her hugs. But we know her spirit is around us as we live our lives, and we are comforted by the fact that we know we will be reunited in Heaven.
