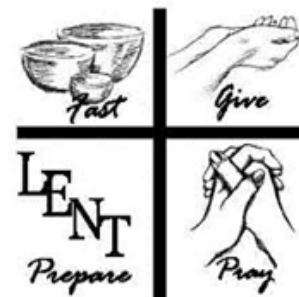
Stations of the Cross

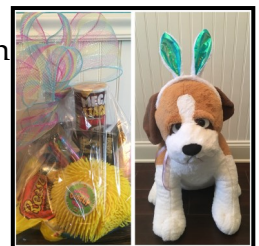
Talent Show
