We have used many methods to have volunteers sign up in the past, but this year we are going to utilize "Sign Up Genius". We have created an online sigh up form for game booths. This will allow individuals to select the date and shift they are available. We are asking each adult (18 and older) volunteer to sign up for a two hour shift.
