WHAT: The 2016 Sticker Stampede is fast approaching. The 6th annual 5K and Fun Run, organized by the St. Joseph's Academy Alumnae Association as a fundraiser for the SJA Alumnae Scholarship, is set for Sunday, December 4, on the SJA campus.
