
## God's Helping Hands

## **Counseling Corner**

This past week in guidance lessons, fourth grade learned about the seven different learning styles. Each student took a survey-type assessment to determine which of the learning styles they are most closely associated with. We then reviewed how knowing your learning style can help you study. In third grade, we discussed working independently. We talked about how it can be difficult, but why it is important to be able to work without asking for help. Lastly, in second grade, we used the feelings thumb ball to talk about various feelings and began discussions on empathy and how it relates to the Golden Rule.
