Counseling Corner

This past week in guidance lessons, first and fifth grade learned about stress relief through the tensing and relaxing of muscles, particularly in the neck, shoulders, and back. In fifth grade, we focused on physical symptoms of stress. They identified particular ones by playing the "Stress Attack" game. We then did three exercises that they can do at their desk at any time. First graders learned four basic moves to help tense and relax their muscles, and also how to help themselves and others when stressed. Ask your students for good stress relieving tips next time you need some!
