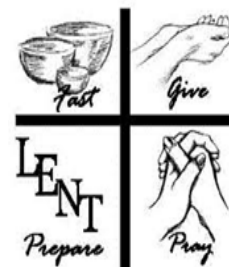


Please Note!!

Counseling Corner

This past week in guidance lessons, first grade learned about self-control while also reviewing how to follow directions and tattling. Fifth grade continued working on their career collages, which incorporated a future career, and what they would like their life to look like. In middle school, seventh grade discovered comfort zones. We discussed three different zones that most activities fall into: comfort, challenge, and panic. They learned that everyone puts different activities in different categories. What's a comfort zone to one person, maybe a panic zone to another. In sixth grade, we learned about the last habit of Stephen Covey's 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens: Sharpen the Saw. This habit is about recharging ourselves to make us better and more capable. We need to recharge mentally, physically, spiritually, and social/emotionally.
