Counseling Corner

This past week in guidance lessons, first and fifth grade learned about dealing with anger. In fifth grade, the class discussed what anger physically feels like and what happens to their bodies. They then put together a puzzle of coping skills that they can use when they feel anger coming on. Some of these include: playing with a pet, talk to an adult, read the Bible, and punch a pillow, among others. In first grade, the students worked in pairs and used marshmallows and toothpicks to create a marshmallow family. They then described what anger looks like in their own family. We then discussed appropriate ways to show anger.

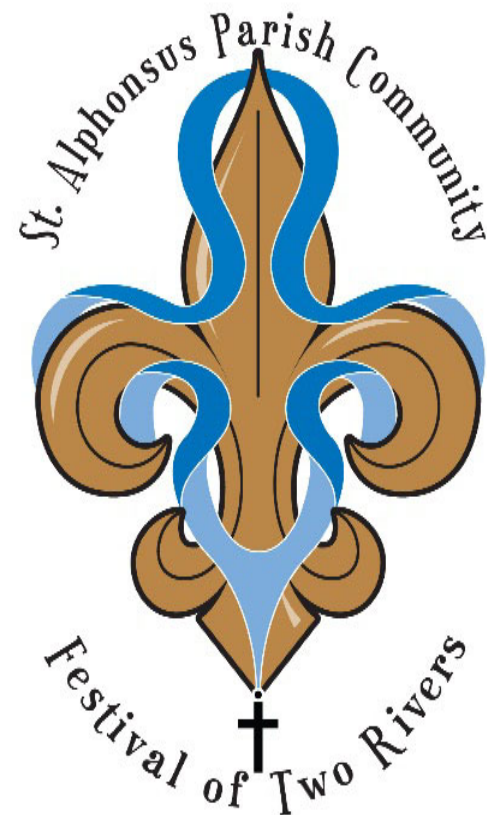
