

## Requirements to receive an invitation to join the SAS Junior Beta Club:

- Demonstrate worthy character, creditable achievement, and commendable attitude
- Maintain at least A/B honor roll.

\*\*\*\*Students who fail to maintain the necessary GPA at the end of the nine-week period or those who earn a letter grade of "C" in any subject including conduct will be placed on probation until the following grading period. At then end of said probationary period, any student who fails to achieve the necessary academic requirements or who fails to bring up their "C" will be withdrawn from Beta membership.

\*\*\*\*Any grade earned below a "C" in any core subject including conduct, as stated above, as well as more than one "C" per grading period will be automatically withdrawn as a member from our rolls.

- Meet service requirements. Service hours are due by December 15, 2022
  - Elementary Division (4th and 5th grade)- 5 service hours
  - Middle School Division (6th-7th grade)- 7 service hours
  - Middle School Division (8th grade)- one service project completed with moderators
- Participate in the annual induction ceremony.
- Attend after-school meetings.

## Requirements to maintain membership in the SAS Junior Beta Club:

- Academic probation will be instated if a Beta member:
  - Makes one C in their report card. Students will stay on probation until the following grading period.
  - Receives more than one C in a grading period or fails to bring up a C while on probation they will be withdrawn from the Beta Club.
  - Fails to complete the required service hours.
