Spirit t-shirt – Spirit shirts can be purchased at Cross Threads in Central. No other SAS shirts are allowed. They may be worn with school uniform shorts (navy or plaid) or the following:

Jeans – Long, solid blue color. No decorations, embellishments, writings, or prints, and must be worn at the waist. No dragging hemlines, rips, tears, frayed hemlines or seams. Girls must wear

modest fit or relaxed fit jeans. NO SKINNY JEANS.

Medication

Students will not be allowed to call home for forgotten items as well. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation with this matter.

Checkouts

Students will not be allowed to check out after 3:00 p.m. This is to ensure the safety of all students, teachers, and staff.

Afternoon Announcements/ Change in Dismissal

If your child will be going home a different way than what is normal, please fill out the **Change in Dismissal Form** that is on the school website and send it to school with your child. This form eliminates the small notes that may get lost in the shuffle of the day. If for some reason you need to change the dismissal way once your child is at school, please call the school office before 2:45 p.m. for them to be placed on Afternoon Announcements.

Carpool

- Slow down and be alert!
- Cell phone use is prohibited when in the carpool lane.
- DO NOT ENTER
 ON GREENWELL SPRINGS
 ROAD IN FRONT OF THE
 CHURCH! The turning lane is not
 allowed to back up traffic on
 Greenwell Springs Rd.
- Bus lane entrance is for BUSES ON-LY.
- Be aware of not blocking the bus exit in the afternoon. This holds up the line and buses cannot make the wide turn.
- Students should be ready to exit the car when a duty teacher arrives. If you need more time, we ask that you park and then rejoin the line.
- For afternoon carpool, please do not skip parking spots. Park in the next available spot.
- Carpool signs are required to be hanging from your rearview mirror. If you need additional carpool signs you can call the office at 225-261-5299 or email Mrs. Erin

Starting this week, all cars without the correct carpool sign will have to go to the office to collect your child. We always want to make sure that our students get home safely and with the correct people.

Dear St. Alphonsus Parents,

I would like to invite all 4th-8th grade students to join the St. Alphonsus Beginner Band! Band students will learn to play a musical instrument, read music, and perform together. Student do not need to have any musical experience to join the band! I will teach the students everything they need to know about their instruments, including how to put them together, how to hold them, how to play them, and how to read music. Band students will have the opportunity to participate in a Christmas Concert and a Spring Concert.

The Beginner Band instruments are:
Flute
Clarinet
Alto Saxophone
Trumpet
Trombone
Percussion (drums, orchestra bells)

Beginner Band rehearsals will be held at school on Tuesday, Thursday, and every other Friday mornings at 7:15 for the remainder of the school year. The first rehearsal will be on September 12th.

Band fees are \$200 per semester, and students will need to rent an instrument from Music and Arts, Music Time or another music store.

Band students will be able to indicate a preferred instrument choice, but final instrumental assignments will be made by the director to ensure balance in the band. Once the registration form is turned in, parents will receive an e-mail discussing instrument options.

If your child is interested in Band, please complete the Band registration form and return it to the school office. Fees will be paid through FACTS.
