

Public Notification 2025-2026 School Year Asbestos Management Plan Availability

This is to serve notice that the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires all schools conduct detailed inspections to identify all asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) that may be present in the school environment. AHERA requires the inspection results and the associated Management Plan be submitted to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ). A copy of the Management Plan must be maintained at the administrative office for review by the public.

St. Alphonsus School maintains a proactive asbestos awareness program. This letter of notification is an annual requirement to the public. If there are any questions, please contact the school principal at 225-261-5299.
