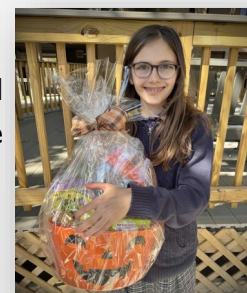
SAS Sweatpants/Winter Attire

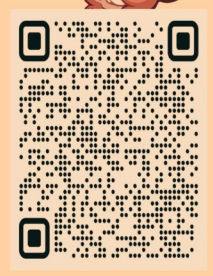
