TIPS FOR HELPING KIDS STAND UP TO BULLYING

Teach Kids To Recognize Bullying

When kids know what bullying is – and what it isn’t – it’s easier for them to be aware of it and report it!

Bullying is behavior that is:

- Repeated
- On Purpose
- Hurtful
- One-sided

There are different types of bullying, including:

- Physical
- Cyber
- Verbal
- Social or Emotional

Teach Kids To Stand Up For Themselves

What They Can Do:

- Walk away.
- Tell an adult.
- Stay calm.
- Say something funny to lighten the situation.
- Don’t respond to what the person is saying – ignore it.
- Try to stay away from the person.

What They Can Say:

- Stop.
- That isn’t funny.
- I don’t care what you think.
- I’m not going to do what you tell me to do.
- What you are doing isn’t nice.
- I’m not going to let you treat me like that.



Teach Kids To Stand Up For Others

- Don’t laugh or join in with the person who is doing the bullying
- Tell the person to stop being mean
- Help the person who is being bullied get away from the person who is doing the bullying
- Talk to an adult you trust about what you’ve seen
- Be a friend to someone who is being picked on

Practice!

- Identify examples of bullying that you see in movies, TV shows, or books.
- Role play with your child. Have them practice standing up for themselves and others. The more comfortable they are doing this, the easier it will be to stand up for themselves and others in real life.
