A Note from Ms. Morgan

Our guidance classes continue to be lots of fun as students learn and grow in their social-emotional skills! Pre-k and kindergarten students are continuing to learn about the "Spot of Emotions." In our most recent class, we focused on our "Happiness Spot" and what brings us happiness and how we can grow our spot. In first grade, students practiced self-control skills through a fun and engaging game of animal feelings charades. Second and third grades are learning about empathy and how to recognize and think about the feelings of others. Fourth grade guidance focused on respect — what it means to respect others and ourselves, and how that looks in everyday situations. In fifth grade, students are exploring empathy and bullying through role-play group scenarios, helping them better understand how their words and actions impact others. Middle school is also focusing on bullying prevention. Specifically, students worked on identifying the differences between rude, mean, and bullying behaviors using real-life scenarios. Stay tuned to see what we'll be learning about in our next guidance classes!
