SAS Sweatpants/Winter Attire

It's exciting to finally get some cooler weather! See below for the SAS Handbook policy on SAS sweatpants. PLEASE - label all sweatshirts and jackets.

 SAS sweatpants may be worn to school on any day from November 1st through February 28th. Outside of this time period, the weather must be 50 degrees or lower at 7:45 a.m. to wear sweatpants. Once the sweatpants are worn to school, the student will not be allowed to remove the sweatpants. This includes P.E. and recess. The sweatpants must be worn with the school uniform shirt.

SANTA

- Pictures with Santa will take place on Tuesday, November 11th.
- Order envelopes were sent home this week.
- If you would like your child(ren) to take a
 picture with Santa, please complete the picture
 envelope and return it to school by Tuesday,
 November 11th.
- When you complete your envelope, please indicate one of two options:
 - 1.Write "Individual Picture(s)" on the envelope if you would like your child(ren) to take picture with Santa alone.
 - 2.Write "Sibling Picture", and list the siblings names and homerooms on the envelope if you would like your children to take a sibling group picture.
- Send separate envelopes and payments for each individual picture needed.
- Send one envelope and payment, with the oldest child, for sibling/group pictures.
- If you would like younger siblings to be in the picture, these pictures will be taken first in the morning. Please drop off your child as usual and enter through the school office with siblings at 8:20 a.m.
- Pictures will be taken in the school library.
- If your child is taking a picture, they will need to arrive at school on time. We may not be able to accommodate photos for students who are late.

All students taking a picture with Santa will be allowed to wear "free dress" attire with the following guidelines:

 Students may wear "Sunday best", jeans, or Christmas attire, AS LONG AS THE CLOTHING IS APPROPRIATE IN LENGTH AND STYLE FOR SCHOOL.

**Keep in mind that students will remain in this attire for the school day. We will not allow students to change clothes before or after photos.

- All shirts and dresses MUST have a sleeve.
- Shoes must be FLAT and have a back. Cowboy boots are not allowed. "Ugg boots" or winter boots are allowed as long as they do not have heels. (This is for safety!)
- If your child has P.E. on Tuesday, he/she must bring tennis shoes to participate.

Students not taking pictures with Santa have the option to wear regular spirit dress or a Christmas shirt with spirit dress guidelines.

TIPS FOR HELPING KIDS UNDERSTAND THEIR EMOTIONS

Why It Matters

We all experience many different emotions each day. Being able to recognize and identify these emotions make it easier to:

- Control and manage our emotions
- Identify the emotions of others
- Tell others how we feel
- Be compassionate to others
- Remember that emotions don't last forever
- Understand what you like and don't like
- Feel comfortable with the different emotions you have

Activity Ideas

- Choose a "feeling of the day/week." During that time period, talk about what might cause someone to feel that way and when you've felt that way. Then, have each person in the family try to really pay attention to when they feel that way during the week. You can also try to notice when the people around you are feeling that way.
- Make a feelings chart with your child. Together, think of different feelings and draw, or have your child draw, pictures of each one. You could also make a feelings chart with photos of your child acting out each emotion.
- Make it a habit to do a feelings check-in as a family. You can do this any time, or during regular routines like before bed, during dinner, or while you're in the car.
- Look at characters in books, movies, and shows and talk about how you think they are feeling. Talk about why you think they are feeling that way.



Talk About It

Here are some discussion questions to help your child grow in this area:

- "It seems like you might be feeling ___. Is that right?"
- "How are you feeling right now?"
- "Why do you think it's important to know how you're feeling?"
- "Is it easy or hard for you to talk about how you're feeling?"

Other Tips

- Model this skill for your child. When appropriate, share how you're feeling and why.
- The best time to work on helping your child understand their emotions is when they are calm. This makes it easier to practice and become more comfortable with the skill.




