TIPS FOR HELPING KIDS PRACTICE GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP

Be Clear About What Sportsmanship Is

Teaching kids about what sportsmanship is (and what it's not) will help them know what is expected of them. A definition of sportsmanship is "respecting yourself, other players, coaches, and officials, regardless of whether you win or lose." Here are some examples of what that looks like during and after the game.

What to do when you are playing:

- Follow the rules.
- Be kind and encouraging to your teammates and the people you are playing against.
- Listen to the referees or judges.
- Help any players who are hurt.
- Keep trying even if you are losing.

What to do when you win:

- Don't brag to the other team or players about winning.
- Give the other team or players space to calm down if they are upset.
- Tell the other team or players, and your own teammates, "good job."
- If possible, wait to celebrate until you are away from the losing team.

What to do when you lose:

- Kindly congratulate the other team.
- Be kind to yourself, your teammates, your opponents, and the officials.
- If you are upset, take deep breaths, or go to a quiet area to calm down.
- Remind yourself that it's okay to lose, and that you can learn from any mistakes you made.

Practice With Fun Activities

Sportsmanship is a skill that can be developed with time and practice. Try playing games with your child that have many chances to win or lose within the game. Some examples include:

Chutes and Ladders
 Spot It!
 Sorry or Trouble

Your child can also learn about sportsmanship by watching games or sports. Watch your child's favorite sport or game with them and look for examples of good sportsmanship.

To add some fun, you can make it a competition to see who can notice the most examples of positive sportsmanship. This will help your child become more aware of it and may also give them a chance to practice being a respectful winner or loser!



Anthony Everett Terrell is 6 years old.

He loves Spider-Man, Jiu jitsu, being outdoors, swinging on the rings, swinging a baseball bat, Sonic, Legos, playing games, his older brother Seth, his big sister Abra Rose, and his family.

He was diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) on March 14, 2023.

He has been undergoing treatment as part of a study through St. Jude since he arrived at St. Jude in Memphis via ambulance on March 15, 2023.

Although he has been in remission since the end of the 2023 school year, he must finish the remaining 56 weeks of chemotherapy and treatment per the study protocol.

He missed the last three months of kindergarten in 2023, but graduated on time that May. He spent 3/4 of his first-grade year learning his lessons at home, but was able to finish the last two months in person.

At the end of his treatment, he will be checked on a regular schedule to assure he stays in remission.

He is limited on playing sports, can't jump on trampolines, or do Jiu jitsu until his port is removed from his chest at the completion of his treatment. Other than that, he's a normal 6-year-old little boy.
