TIPS FOR HELPING KIDS WITH IMPULSE CONTROL

What It Is

Impulse control is the ability to resist a desire or temptation. Examples include:

- Choosing not to say something mean
- Finishing homework before playing
- Not yelling or being aggressive when angry
- Saying no to something that isn't good for you
- Saying no to things that won't help you reach your goals
- Thinking about the consequences of your words and actions

Why It Matters

Impulse control may have many lifelong benefits including:

- Increased ability to meet goals
- · Improved academic performance
- · Better friendships and relationships
- Improved physical health


Increasing Awareness

Children may struggle with impulse control because they aren't aware of their own thoughts, feelings, and actions. Here are some ways to help your child grow in this area:

- Make a habit of doing "feelings check-ins."
- Practice slowing down and being aware of yourself through deep breathing or mindfulness.
- Help your child come up with statements they can use to remind themselves of the benefits of impulse control.

How To Help

- Be clear and specific about the behaviors that you want to encourage.
- When possible, remove distractions and temptations.
 This can make it easier, especially at first, for your child to develop the skill of impulse control.
- Use visual cues like signs or hand motions to remind your child to practice impulse control.
- Come up with a codeword that you can use to gently let your child know that they aren't using impulse control.
- Teach "replacement behaviors."
 These are things that your child can do in place of an undesired behavior. For example, instead of blurting out, help your child learn to raise their hand or write down their thoughts.
- Play games like Jenga, Memory, Red Light Green Light, and
